## Two Combat Wounded Warriors from Camp Pendleton, CA throw out

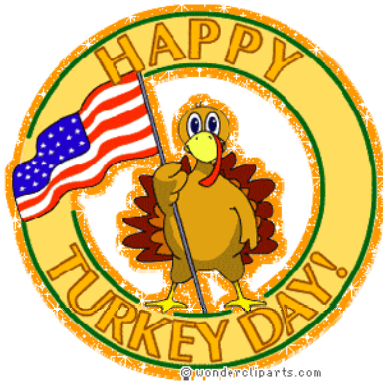
